What we store	Tappin uses Google Cloud for office tools like documents, spreadsheets, data storage, presentation, mail, calendar etc.
Geo location of data	All data is stored only within EU/EEC
Type of data	Mostly internal documents but also lists of users and some user information for events.
Reason for use	Needed to supply customers with the service needed to deliver the services we sell.
Risk of transfer to countries outside EU / EEC	The risk of transfer of data outside EU / EEC is very low. All data is stored exclusivly inside the area and as tappin never uses support from Google the risk of support workers in USA access the data is close to zero.
Other risks	There is always a risk that employees does not follow the security protocols at all times, but this risk is minimal.
Summary	Google is a industry leader and the risk of using this service is minimal.
